

Orange or Coal

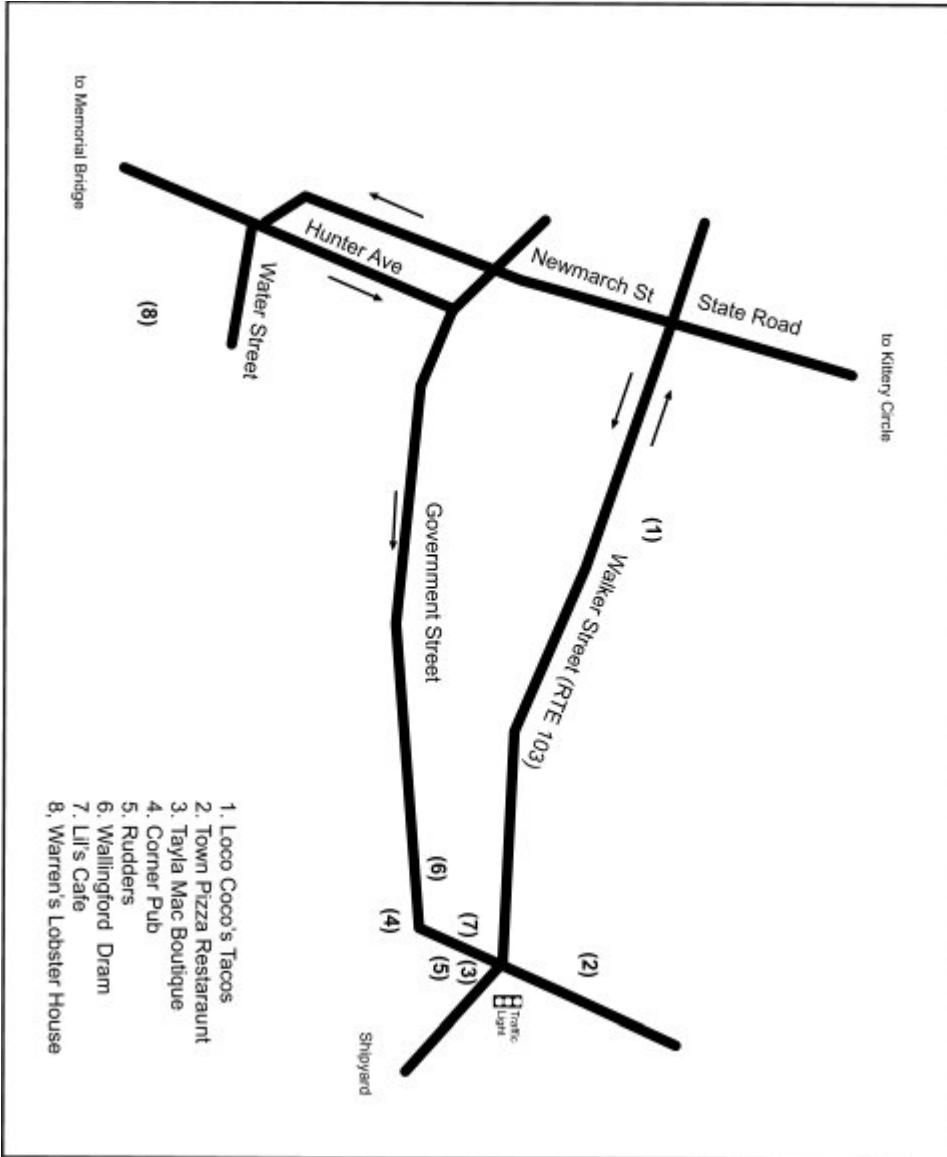
The budget mystery has been solved!! Its actually better news than you might think.
