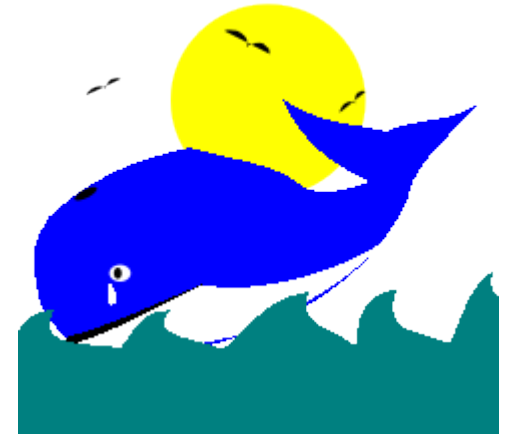


Undeniable Facts
