continuum and have to find the end to something else.

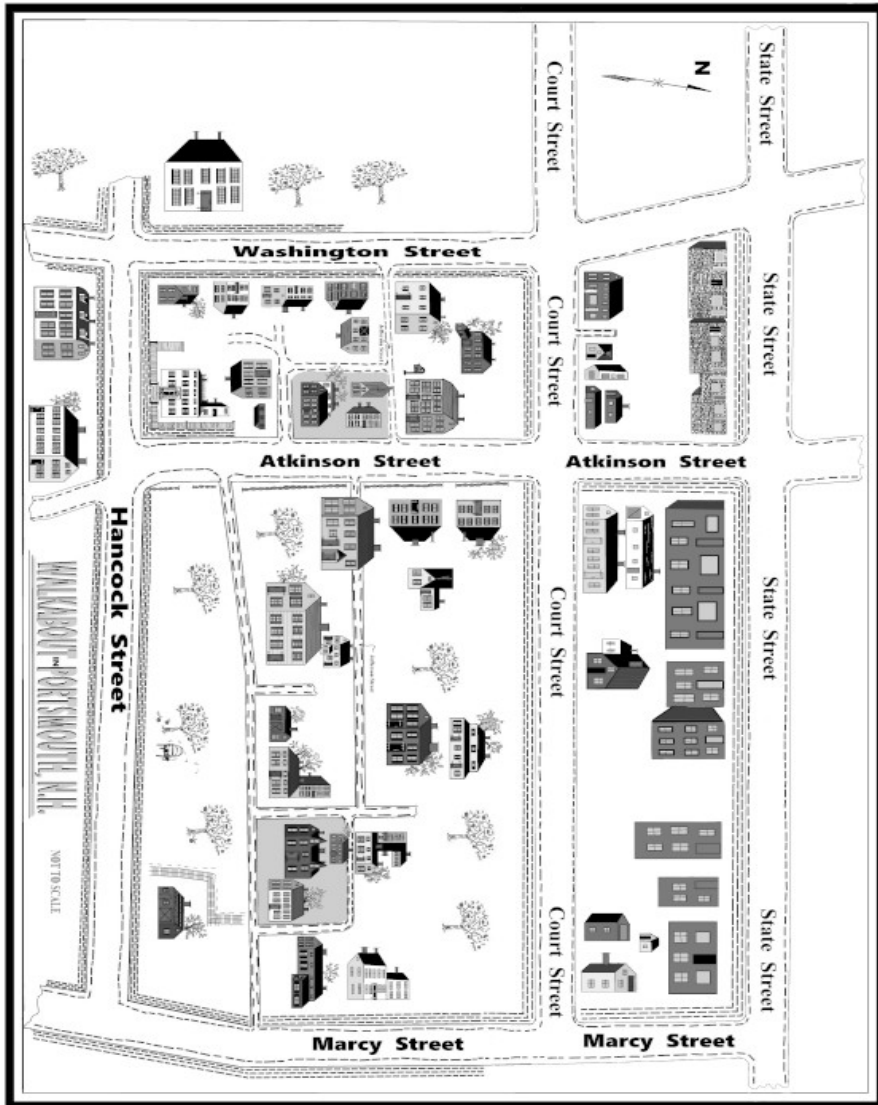
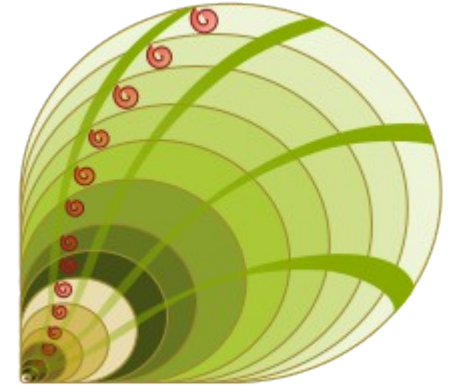
He was questioned... why do you believe in the continuum when in
