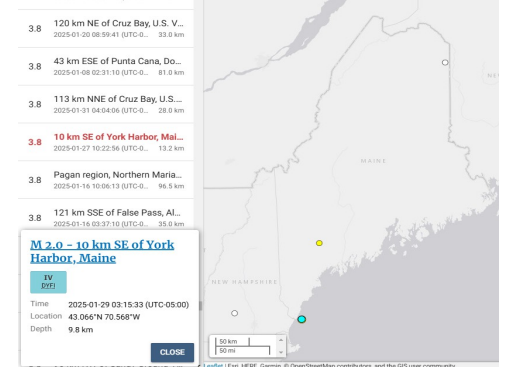


## E-quake
